Chairman Wilhite called the meeting to order and asked if there were any changes from the January 4, 2023 minutes. There being no corrections. <u>Councilman Larry Crawford made a motion, seconded by Linc</u> Polk to accept the January 4, 2023 minutes as written. All present voted "Aye".

### **Old Business:**

# a. Discussion on County Federal ARP Matching Funds

Mayor McTizic informed the Utility Board that the County Mayor and Commissioners have withdrawn the Federal ARP amount they had committed to providing to the city for help in matching the TDEC ARP Water/Sewer Grant. The mayor went on to say that the County withdrew the amounts they had committed to all municipalities in the county and not just Bolivar. The amount the County had committed to the City of Bolivar Utility Department was \$255,036.46. Cliff Henson and Mayor McTizic explained to the board that the TDEC portion of money can not be withdrawn since a Resolution was passed for this. They are asking the board for approval to take the \$255,036.46 out of the Utility Fund Balance. <u>Councilman Larry Crawford made a motion, seconded by Paul Fuller to approve taking the \$255,036.46 from the Utility Fund Balance and forward a favorable recommendation to the Council for approval. All present voted "Aye".</u>
